
This is in response to your letter dated July 10, 2013, received in the Information Management Division of the Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI) on July 11, 2013. Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), you are requesting ***“certifications and supporting information regarding related policies and procedures received by ODNI and submitted by Intelligence Community Elements and agencies in possession of classified information pursuant the Presidential Policy Directive 19 (PPD-19), Sections A and B.”***

We have accepted your request. It will be processed in accordance with the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended. We will limit our search to records existing up to and including the date that the ODNI begins a search.

Since we may be unable to provide a response within the 20 working days stipulated by the FOIA, you have the right to consider this response as a denial and may appeal to the ODNI, Information Management Office, Washington, DC 20511 within 45 days of the date of this letter. It would seem more reasonable, however, to allow us sufficient time to continue processing your request and respond as soon as we can. You will have the right to appeal any denial of records at that time. Unless we hear from you otherwise, we will assume that you agree and will continue processing your FOIA request on this basis.
