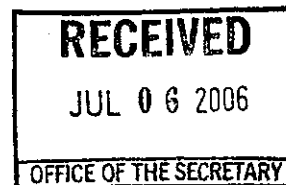

I was formerly a Branch Chief in the Division of Enforcement and resigned effective June 9, 2006, to accept employment with the broker-dealer Credit Suisse.
